1. Best Kept Village Competition. TOSTOCK IS IN THE FINALS for the County Competition, and in addition has WON the Thedwastre Rural District Council prize of £25. Many people have worked hard to achieve this success. Every effort will be made to keep the Fison Trophy. Anyone wishing to join the Volunteer Working Party is requested to be on the Green on Monday 19th July at 6 p.m. onwards.
FINALS - In the County Competition TOSTOCK and SAWTON DOWNHAM in West Suffolk and EASTON and HORHAM in East Suffolk will be judged on FRIDAY 23rd JULY. The judges will arrive at Tostock at 2.45 p.m. that day.
2. Clay Pigeon Shoot. This annual event organised by the Fete Committee is being held, by kind permission of Mr. A. E. Henderson, in the Park of Tostock Place on Saturday 24th JULY commencing at 3 p.m. A large entry of leading "guns" from the Eastern Counties is expected. Proceeds will be given to the Improved Village Hall Fund. All persons willing to assist with the operation of the traps etc. please inform Mr. J. Glendinning.
3. The Fete. The Fete to raise money for the Improved Village Hall Fund will be held, again by kind permission of Mr. A. E. Henderson, in the Park of Tostock Place on Saturday 31st JULY commencing at 2.30 p.m. Attractions include Childrens Sports, Sideshow, Stalls, Dog Handling, Judo, Car Treasure Hunt, Barbecue, Dance, Swinging Boats etc. etc.
An OPEN MEETING will be held in the Village Hall on TUESDAY next 20th JULY at 7.30 p.m. which all persons willing to help with the various stalls, sideshows, etc. are invited to attend.
A door-to-door collection will be made during the week commencing Monday 26th July when items for the Produce Stall, New Stall, Bottle Stall, etc. will be gratefully received.
4. Village Hall. The Parish Council has accepted responsibility for future action concerning the Village Hall and for all money raised by the Fete Committee. The Hall Management Committee have paid over to the Hon. Treasurer of the Parish Council the sum of £110:5:2d. which was the balance in the Deposit Account known as the Village Hall Improvement Fund. There is now only one Fund, viz. the Improved Village Hall Fund controlled by the Parish Council. The Parish Council has made the following announcement:- "The Parish Council has had offers of two sites for a new Villags Hall and Playing Field. Both have been inspected by the council who are now considering which will be most suitable. Residents will be informed of any further progress."
A Parish Meeting will be convened when a decision can be made.
5. Womens' Institute. The Insitute is holding a Sale in the Villags Hall on Saturday 4th SEPTEMBER at 2.30 p.m. The proceeds will be used to provide a seat for the elderly people commemorating the Jubilee Year of the National Federation of Womens' Institutes.
6. Methodist Chapel. A Sale was held in the Village Hall on Saturday 10th JULY for the benefit of the Chapel Improvement Fund. The sum of £40. was raised. Members of the Chapel wish to express their thanks to the many kind helpers who made the Sale a success.
